

DANCE DRESS CODE/CONDUCT POLICY

Attending the SkillsUSA dance is privilege. If any delegate violates the dance policy, they will be asked to leave. Any advisor can ask a student to leave.

SkillsUSA dance dress and behavior code of conduct is listed below. Students must abide by the following:

- Students must wear a chapter or conference SkillsUSA t-shirt or conference polo. Shirts may not be tied around the waist or shoulders. Requiring students to wear a SkillsUSA shirt helps us identify quickly whether or not the student is a SkillsUSA student and helps us keep non-SkillsUSA members from attending our dances.
- 2. If a student does not have a SkillsUSA shirt to wear with their jeans, they must wear the official SkillsUSA uniform or business attire.
- 3. Students may wear clean jeans. Holes or cuts in them which shows skin is not acceptable. No underwear or midriffs showing at any time.
- 4. No cutoff jeans, no shorts allowed.

Lagree to the following rules for the SkillsUSA dance:

- 5. Students must wear their SkillsUSA conference name badge where it can be easily read.
- 6. Teachers must turn in student signed dance policy form at registration.
- 7. Advisors **MUST** have a chaperone present if any of their students are at the dance.
- 8. No inappropriate or provocative dancing will be tolerated.
- 9. Students are not allowed to sit on other students' shoulders.
- 10. At the discretion of the SkillsUSA advisors, chaperones, and/or security, any student failing to abide by the dance guidelines or showing disrespect will be asked to leave the dance.
